SCHOOL RULES AND GUIDELINES GENERAL RULES FORM #3 [PLEASE RETAIN]

- 1. Students should take care of school related business and personal matters before school, during recess, or after school hours.
- 2. Students shall not leave the classroom without permission. Students shall never be outside the classroom during class time without permission.
- 3. Students are required to obtain permission from the teacher before leaving the school campus during school hours.
- 4. Students must wear closed toe shoes during school hours.
- 5. Electronic devices such as radios, personal audio player, tape recorders, and game devices may not be brought to school.
- 6. Use of cell phones and IPods is NOT allowed during class hours. Without exception, any infraction will result in the teacher confiscating the device until the end of the school day. With a parent present, the device can be reclaimed at the end of the school day.
- 7. Students shall keep their hands and unkind remarks to themselves. The Golden Rule is worth practicing: "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."

TUITION REFUND POLICY

With the exception of the *Tuition Refund Program (TRP)*, defined below, all registration and all fees/payments are nonrefundable and nontransferable

Discounts

Sibling Discount: A discount is available to every family with more than one student at SVJLI. Full tuition is paid for the oldest student and the discount applies to each additional enrolled sibling. (Please see the Tuition and fees schedule)

Annual Pay Discount: A discount is available on tuitions paid in full by cash, check or the like. Annual payments <u>must</u> be received by the specified dates on the Tuition and fees schedule or at the time of enrollment to qualify for this discount. (Please see the Tuition and fees schedule)

Tuition Refund Program

The Tuition Refund Program (TRP) is designed to protect the tuition investment of those families who have enrolled and paid for the full year tuition, but find themselves unable to attend SFVJLI for either of the following reasons:

- 1. The family is moving more than 50 miles away from SFVJLI; or
- 2. The student is unable to attend SFVJLI due to medical reasons.

All Families who pay annually are enrolled in the Tuition Refund Program.

Families must submit in writing their reason for withdrawal on the Termination Form. Tuition is payable until the Termination form is submitted. If it meets the TRP criteria, families receive a refund equal to 100 % of the unused portion of tuition.

Payment Guidelines

If you pay by check, please note the student's name and purpose of payment with the amount to apply to each category.

Any cash tuition payment must be made in the school office where a receipt will be issued.

SFVJLI's Relationship with SFVJACC

It has come to our attention that some of you are not clear of our school's relationship with the San Fernando Valley Japanese American Community Center ("CC") as you were required to pay to become CC member as part of your application to our school. Our school (Japanese Language Institute or "JLI") and CC are separate legal entity; however, we are related in that JLI belong to the CC's Coordinating Council. We have been working as partners for many years.

These are the benefit the JLI receive from CC, free of charge:

- 1) Use of the land. JLI owns the school building, but it is on CC's land.
- 2) Use of the playground. The playground is owned by the CC, but JLI should take care of the maintenance, since we are the only organization using it at this time.
- 3) Use of the parking lots. The lots are owned by the CC. The nice newly paved parking lot repairs were paid by the CC.
- 4) Use of the restrooms. The building that the restrooms are located is owned by the CC. As we use them the most, we are responsible for cleaning them. The maintenance is done by the CC.
- 5) Use of the Pioneer Building. This is where our holiday program, New Year Party, Reading/Speech Contests and other activities are held.
- 6) Use of the kitchen. This is where we do our cooking classes, make our fundraiser food such as Kurimanju and Curry Rice, and hold meetings.
- 7) Use of the Gym and tables and chairs in the gym. We use the Gym as our back up for our children's day picnic and we use the tables and chairs for our yard sales
- 8) CC pays for all the utilities and WiFi used by JLI.

CC does not ask JLI to pay rent or usage fee for any of the items listed above. This is a significant assistance is keeping our operating expenses low, which in turn keeps our tuition at our current level. The CC only requests that all JLI families become CC members as they want us to be part of the Community.

These are the benefit that JLI families, as the CC member, receive from the CC:

- Access to various activities/clubs/classes such as youth basketball, craft classes, various exercise classes (including zumba), music and dance classes, and many senior citizen classes (for grandparents and for some of us that will get there soon). Some classes and clubs may charge minimal additional fees.
- 2) Invitations to various functions and fundraisers. Donations/attendance to these functions is not required. Please donate and attend these functions as you see fit.
- 3) Subscription to the bi-monthly newsletters. We are allowed to turn in articles/announcements for the newsletter.
- 4) Use of the facilities such as the Pioneer Center, kitchen, and the Gym, for approved parties/functions at minimal charge.
- 5) Eligibility for various college scholarships for graduating High School Seniors.
- 6) Eligibility to help at various events for high school students to receive community service hours.
